FLOODING INFORMATION

How can the Town Council Help?

The Town Council has a set of pumping equipment for flooding situations which can be borrowed by householders and businesses alike.

The pumps are free to borrow for non-sewage flooding (including burst pipes).

You must look after them and provide petrol or electricity to power them.

What equipment is available?

Petrol driven 3 inch (75mm)



1000litres per minute 500m discharge pipework.
Outside drainage only.

Electric 2 inch pump



High discharge. Inside or outside use

Electric 1 inch pump



Pumps down to 0.5inches (12mm) depth. Inside use only

How do I arrange to get a pump?

The dedicated Howden Floodline is held by Town Councillors and the number to call is:

As volunteers hold it, you may have to leave a message We will usually come to have a look at the problem to be certain something can be done – we don't want to cause another flooding problem by solving yours!

What if I don't know what to do with a pump?

The equipment will be delivered by one of our councillors and volunteers who will be able to set the equipment up for you and show how it works. If you need more help then they will be able to arrange that.

Priority

If we receive a lot of calls for the equipment then we will have to give priority to places where the houses are in danger of flooding.
